Refund Policy

The registration fee is a donation towards the operation of Oak Ridge Little League.

The following is Oak Ridge Little League's refund policy of the registration fee:

In order to receive any refund due, the parent/guardian of a player must submit a letter to the player agent requesting the refund. The letter must include the player's name, division and team (if known) and the reason why the player is resigning from Oak Ridge Little League. **No refunds are processed without this letter. All uniforms which have been issued must be returned before a refund request will be considered.**

The amount of the refund will be based on the following situations:

A player who resigns, quits or is lost for the season due to injury:

- Prior to team assignments : A \$25.00 administrative fee will be charged and the remaining balance will be refunded.
- After team assignments: 50% of the registration fee will be refunded. **Again, if the uniform has been issued, the refund will be processed once any uniform items have been returned to the Equipment Director.**
- There will be no refund of the registration fee after the start of the regular season, which is Opening Day.

Spaghetti Feed/Uniform Distribution Committee

Assist in the organization and implementation of our major fundraising event. This will include setting/cleaning up, food prep and service, raffle ticket Sales, checking in families and other duties as necessary



Opening Day Committee

Assist in the organization and implementation of Opening Day activities. This will include set up/clean up, preparation for our annual pancake breakfast, lunch food service, spiritwear sales, working a booth or activity, etc.



Team Parent:

Assist manager and coaches in coordination of activities other than coaching. This will include snack shack schedules, team snack schedule, distribution of team correspondence, team banner etc.



Field Maintenance

Assist field coordinators and managers in maintaining all fields. This will include mowing, raking, weeding etc.
